## **Baked Chicken Supreme**

Baked Corn

(This delicious Holiday dinner can be prepared for under \$20)

## **Chicken Supreme**

2 chicken breasts

1 can cream of celery soup

1/2 cup milk

1/2 teaspoon pepper

Pound and tenderize chicken breasts. Place on griddle and add 1 tablespoon olive oil and butter, cook slowly until browned. In skillet combine soup, milk and pepper. Heat to boiling. Add grilled chicken breasts and let simmer 10 to 15 minutes.

## **Baked Corn**

2 cans yellow cream corn

4 tablespoons flour

1 small jar pimentos

2 tablespoons sugar

1 teaspoon salt

1/3 cup milk

3 eggs

(saute 1/4 of a green bell pepper, chopped and 1/4 of an onion chopped in butter until softened) and add to mixture Mix well. Bake in buttered casserole dish at 350 for 45 minutes or until thickened.

## **Cheese Green Beans**

3 slices bacon (fried, reserve bacon grease)

2 cans green beans, drained

1 small can mushrooms, drained

3/4 cup chopped onion

3/4 teaspoon black pepper

1/2 cup grated cheddar cheese

Cook bacon and drain, reserving 1/4 cup bacon grease. Crumble bacon adding mushrooms, onion. Cook over medium heat 10 minutes. Add bacon, beans, pepper mixing well and pour into a 2 quart baking dish. Top with grated cheese. Microwave until hot and cheese is melted. Sprinkle with bacon that is left over.

## **Golden Glow Jello Salad**

Dissolve 1 package orange jello with 1 cup hot water.

Add 1/4 cup sugar and 1 cup pineapple juice. Chill in refrigerator until slightly thickened. Then stir in 1 cup crushed pineapple and 1 cup grated carrots. Return to refrigerator until firm.

## **Syrup Cake**

(This is a very old recipe that my Granny used to make.)

1/2 cup butter

1 cup sugar

3 eggs

2 cups cane syrup

1 cup milk

4 cups flour

1/2 teaspoon ginger

1/2 teaspoon nutmeg

1/2 teaspoon pumpkin pie spice

Mix butter and sugar, add eggs, syrup, milk, flour and spices. Bake in a long pan at 350 degrees for 30 minutes or until firm on top.

Tablescape: A spring floral tablecloth with a 1950's pottery vase in pink and blue in the center of the table with a lily or spring flower in it, surrounded with colorful plastic Easter eggs (we will use later in our Easter egg hunt) and a Easter basket.
